- 1- Poly Accordion File dimensions 9" by 13" with 13 pockets (folders, papers and planner will go inside) \*\* This is a new organizational system.\*\*\*
- 5 two-pocket folders (plastic preferred) 1 each of the following colors: purple, orange, green, red and blue \*\*each color will be assigned to a specific subject the first day of school\*\*
- 3 spiral notebooks - one for math, one for science/social studies and one for ELA
- 1 **yellow Sharpie Accent** highlighter (student keep in pencil pouch)
- 1 pack of Crayola pre-sharpened colored pencils
- 1 zipper pencil pouch
- 1 book bag
